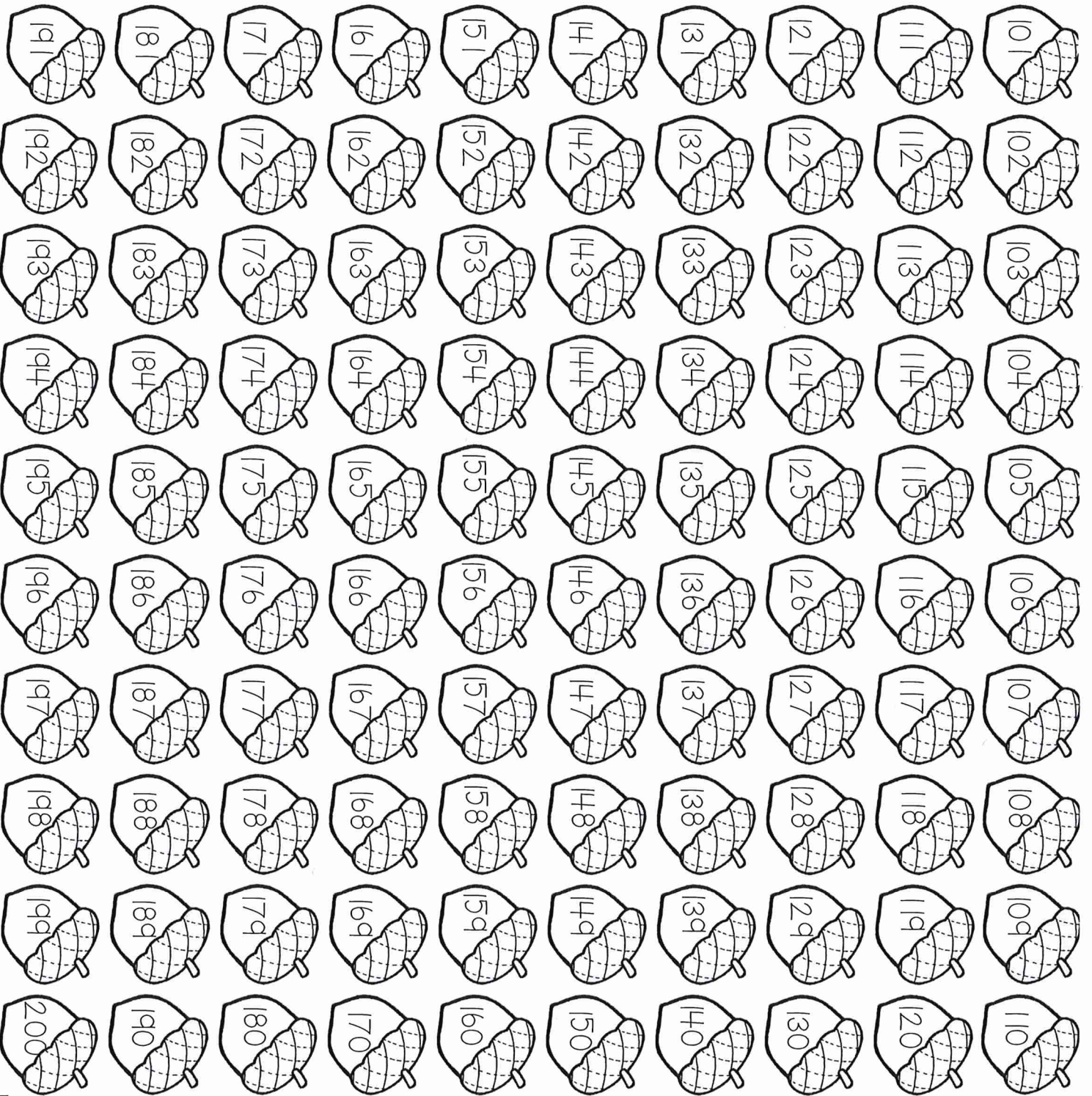

Choose simple songs with lots of repetition, motions, and gestures that go with them. Songs such as The Wheels on the Bus, Head Shoulders Knees and Toes, and The Itsy Bitsy Spider have strong rhythms, vocabulary and grammar appropriate for younger children, and singable melodies. Most of them also have motions to go along with the words, making them a whole-body experience.
